AN EMPOWERED ENCLAVE

Dedicated to playwright, performer and activist Eve Ensler, Ellie Cullman's sexy, sophisticated master bedroom is streamlined in its color palette but accented with lavish details. Faux shagreen walls and high-gloss ecru ceiling framed custom cabinets, while decorative nail head trim, a four-poster bed fitted with Frette linens and natural jute carpet from Taipei provided a richness and subtlety. Colorful photos, sculpture and antique accessories gave the room a warm and personal touch.

In recognition of long-time client Emily Fisher Landau's youthful enthusiasm and support of the arts, Aman & Carson Interiors' library matched sophisticated materials and luxe finishes to produce an elegant environment infused with the
